

“Streams of Living Water”

We start our study this week speaking about the baptism the baptism of water and the baptism of the Holy Spirit that's baptizo in the Greek it means to dip, sink, to make clean with water.

In the Hebrew, there is a ceremonial cleansing in a small pool of water, the container is called "Mikveh" shares the same root word as the word "hope" (tikvah) (kav) for line or alignment.

(Kaw-vaw,) to gather together, to look patiently, wait in confidence and hope on the Lord.

Jeremiah 17: 5 -6, is a metaphor of trees there either rooted and flourishing beside water which is when we trust in God or they're drying up for lack of water when we put our trust in man,

the Lord is the lord of the Living Water Jeremiah 2:13 the people have forsaken about Me, the fountain of living water.

John 7:38 Jesus said whoever believes in me as scripture says from within him will flow rivers of Living Water

John's baptism was not a ritual cleansing that he was doing in the Jordan river he was doing a cleansing of the heart where the people felt led to turn from their deep-seated sins into a manner worthy of the calling of the LORD.

Mark 1:4-11, I baptise you with water, But He/ Jesus will baptise you with the Holy Spirit.

Now after John the Baptist baptized Jesus in the Jordan River the Holy Spirit descended on him like as a dove and the heavenly father said "this is my beloved Son in whom I am well pleased"

Jesus being full of the Holy Spirit after he was baptized he was led by the Spirit Into the Wilderness where he was tempted by the devil and Jesus overcame him he was there for 40 days.

Jesus return to Galilee in the power of the Spirit into Nazareth and when he taught in the synagogue he taught from the prophet Isaiah that says the "Spirit of the Lord is upon me because he has anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor, to Proclaim release to the captives, recovery of sight to the blind and set free those who are oppressed and proclaimed a favorable year of the Lord "after He spoke those words He sat down and said this has been fulfilled in your hearing.

Jesus went into another synagogue in Galilee.

Mark 1 21-28, and it said he/ Jesus taught with authority as he teaching the people He was casting out an unclean spirit in the congregation he told the spirit "be quiet and come out of him "and the unclean spirit came out and the people were amazed and said this man is teaching as someone who has Authority

and that's because the power of the Holy Spirit that was in Him and that's the same power and authority that Jesus has given us when we're "Believers" we have that power and authority to help pray and heal the sick and cast out demons and those are things that you don't normally see but Jesus did give us the power to do those things.

I want to focus a minute about rocks about the rocks that you might find in a river the smoother the rock its typically in the center of the river because the water moves the fastest and it clears off the debris, clears off the rough edges of the rock and the rock that you find by the shore usually has algae, slime growing on it because the water stagnant there and this example is just used to illustrate the fact that to be used in a greater way by the Lord we have to be in the center of his will we have to be in the center of the deep water so that the Holy Spirit can move in us, and guide us to His divine will.

John 4: 4- 26 the Bible talks about living water, Jesus spoke with the Samaritan woman and he asked her for a drink of water and there was some debate about that and he then told her that there was living water and that everyone who drinks of this water will never thirst again. But the water I give will become in him a well of water springing up to eternal life.

This is not a natural condition but a " supernatural " condition.

I want to close this teaching with Jesus promise to the "overcomes" who don't fall away in hard times but inherit eternal life in His Kingdom, Rev. 21:6, Then said to me it is done I am the Alpha and the Omega the beginning and the end I will give to the one who thirsts from the spring of the Water of Life without cost. He who overcomes will inherit these things and I will be his God and he will be my son but for the cowardly the unbelieving the abominable murderers and immoral persons, sorcerers and idolaters and all liars their part will be in the lake that burns with fire and brimstone which is the second death.

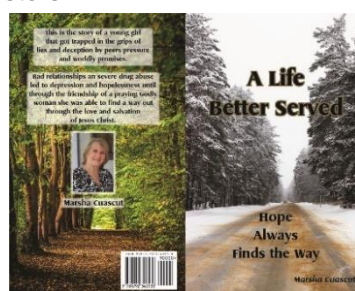
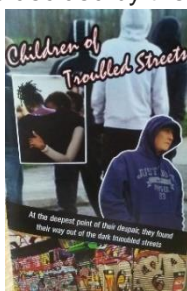
- Marsha's book, "A life Better Served" has been distributed to several women's shelters & we continue to pray for those most in need of this testimonial message.
