Now, let's take a look at our summer in review. Our concert event on April 25th 2009 at Jenkins Auditorium was a success, it was an opportunity for us to come together with Roger Pace, and his team of Godly musicians, many other events were scheduled in Clermont for the same date, so the crowd was not as large as we had hoped for, but over all we felt God had just the right people there that he wanted. We were blessed to come together as a Body for God's honor, and glory. The youth had a good time. So Thanks again to Roger Pace, and all the men of God, who attended and their tireless efforts.

This summer to sum it up in a word "Food" outreach, with the help of other supporting Ministries. Street Gideon Ministries has feed well over 200 families this summer some on a weekly and monthly basis. Praise God. We have been able to take two trips to the Orange Blossom Trail this summer, and bring gift bags full of toiletries, clothes, food and drinks, Bibles and prayer, and most important of all love, and support just to show that God sees their needs, and cares for the homeless. Many lives were brought into the Kingdom, and that's what it's all about. We were blessed to have several of our Board members with us Dr. Al, Brenda Huba, and our precious brother in Christ Brother Bill, who has recovered from life on the street's, and has a great testimony to share. He has since moved on to Mississippi to work in a Ministry there, we will miss him greatly, and know God will bring someone else to work in his place. We also had an opportunity to help deliver food weekly to many families in need in Clermont, and we were able to reach out to an area where there is much oppression in Hernando county called "Lachoochee", which is near Ridge Manor, we were able to take food bags, with non- perishable food items to many families that have been hard hit by these difficult economic times. When we enter the neighborhoods the children run out to meet us, and are so happy, it just fills our hearts with joy to see them encouraged by our presence. Building Blocks Ministries helped us prepare the bags for distribution, and wrote, and drew on the bags so that the families would feel the love of the Lord reaching out to them. Many times we get very hot, and tired from these trips, but the Thank You's from the people, and knowing that for that moment we can be Jesus hands, and feet makes it all worth while. There have been a lot of cut backs in distributing food for now. So we Thank God for this season of being able to help so many families. And continue to look forward to reaching out to the least of these on the streets.

Last but not least to round out our summer, The Ministry went to Precept Ministries in Chattanooga, TN., where Marsha was enrolled to take a basic study called "Precept upon Precept" this course is taken to become a certified Precept teacher. Marsha is continuing these courses of study to learn to teach classes in Inductively Bible study. This will enable Street Gideon Ministry to be able to effectively disciple new believers, and teach Christians that would like to further their understanding of the word of God. This will be an ongoing course of study for Marsha, with many different levels of knowledge to attain to. We are happy, and excited to see the direction that God is leading this Ministry in, and prayerfully look forward to updating our web site sometime in the fall to offer inductive study as an extended part of our teaching facet.

How easy it is when we are going through hard times or seeing someone else go through a difficult time, for our immediate response to be dear God please bring this person what "we" feel they need, so this problem will go away.
