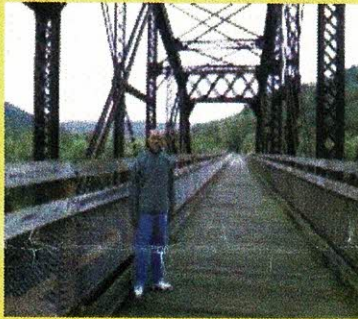


CELEBRATING FIVE (5) YEARS FOR STREET GIDEON MINISTRIES, INC.

Deut. 11: 26-30. Walk in His word Children of G-d & you will receive all of His blessings.



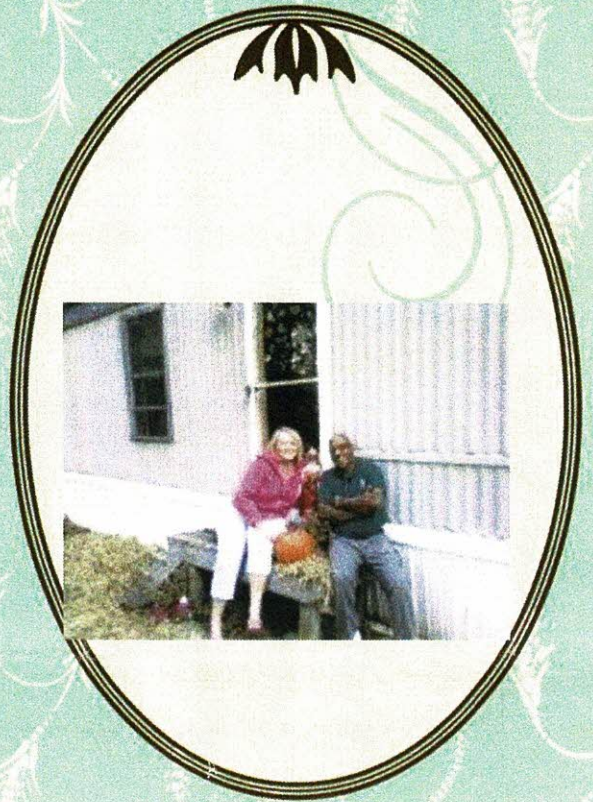
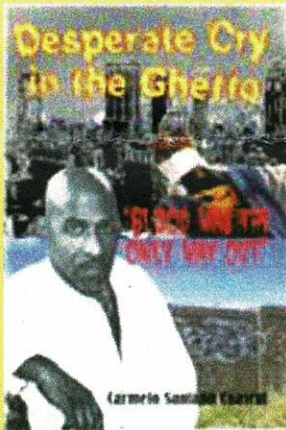
VISION QUEST

FROM THE HEART: The Sweaty Old T-Shirt

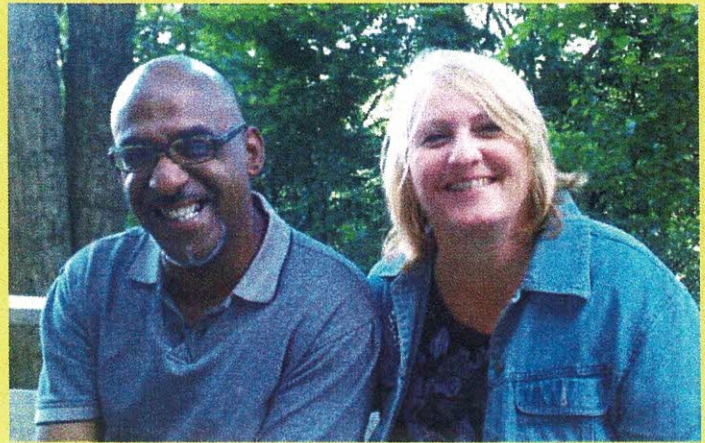
